Office of Development Services – Roy Tipton (see attached)

- Adopt Congressional Directed Spending requests

Tipton discussed Moffat County's submission (\$12,000,000) for this second round of Congressional Directed Spending. It would be used as incentive to attract an Aerospace company to come into this area for economic growth and benefit. Tipton said he didn't know what our chances for success were, but it's worth a shot.

- Letters of Support for Town of Dinosaur and City of Craig

The City of Craig is making a submission for a Congressional Directed Spending request to extend a water line under the river, up to Hwy 394, then to the Airport, Golf Course and Loudy-Simpson Park. This project would be in the \$6,000,000 range.

Bohrer moved to approve the letter of support for the City of Craig for their Congressional Directed Spending request. Villard seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

The Town of Dinosaur is making a submission for a Congressional Directed Spending request to run natural gas for the town. This is a much-needed project.

Villard moved to approve the letter of support for the Town of Dinosaur for their Congressional Directed Spending request. Bohrer seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

- Letter of Support for Congresswoman Boebert's I-70 bill (see attached)

Comstock presented a letter of support for Congresswoman Lauren Boebert's proposed I-70 bill that would study new routes for when I-70 has to close and what kind of improvements need to be made.
