Resolution 2021- 64: A Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Moffat County, Colorado, establishing a Stage 1 Restriction on Open Fires and Open Burning in the Unincorporated Areas of Moffat County. (see attached)

Sheriff Hume came before the BOCC to explain the reasons for seeking Stage 1 fire restrictions. All of our neighboring counties have already gone into Stage 1 restrictions, and the metrics that they use indicate that it's time to move into that phase. He also spoke about a press release that his office has issued along with an "infographic" which details what is or is not allowed. This will take effect at one minute after midnight on Wednesday, June 16. Hume surmised that once the County started experiencing more fires, that would trigger us moving into Stage 2.

Villard made a motion to approve **Resolution 2021- 64:** A Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Moffat County, Colorado, establishing a Stage 1 Restriction on Open Fires and Open Burning in the Unincorporated Areas of Moffat County as presented. Bohrer seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0

Wheeler spoke briefly about the State-based Division of Fire Prevention and Control which has a module based in Routt County. They have dedicated resources to Moffat County in the form of a type-1 helicopter and crew.
