**County Attorney – Rebecca Tyree**

- **Resolution 2021-86:** Resolution Rescinding Resolution(s) 2020-35 - Declaring Local Disaster Emergency & Resolution 2020-96 – Addendum to Resolution to 2020-35

Tyree presented Resolution **2021-86** rescinding two previous Local Disaster Emergency resolutions related to the COVID-19 pandemic. On July 8<sup>th</sup>, the state declared the “emergency” to be over. The Board of County Commissioners had met with Kari Ladrow, Moffat County Public Health Director and Todd Wheeler, Office of Emergency Management Coordinator, and they both recommended that the local disaster resolution be rescinded at this time. Due to there being a vaccination/treatment, the state is in a recovery stage, not a disaster (emergency) stage.

Commissioner Bohrer commented that he had asked Human Resources Director, Lynnette Siedschlaw, to check to see if the State was still going to be giving the County monies towards employees that were
