

Cooperative Weed & Pest Management Partnership Application

This application is for interested groups of landowners seeking to work cooperatively with Moffat County to mitigate noxious weed and pest infestations. Approved projects will be charged \$25.00 / man hour + materials for services rendered on their individual properties. Once a project is approved, a management plan will be developed, and the partnership duration will be established.

Approved projects will be selected based upon annual budget and grant availability, the number of interested partners, species of interest, location, and alignment with noxious weed containment and suppression goals established in the Moffat County Noxious Weed Management Plan.

Landowners are encouraged to collaborate and submit a single application for the entire group. <u>This application will only need to be submitted once</u>. In the case that a project is not selected, the application will automatically be considered the following year.
