
Craig-Moffat County Airport is an active public air transportation center that is open year-round for commercial and private traffic.

The general aviation airport hosts 10,000 or more operations each year.

The Craig-Moffat County Airport is located on 373 acres 4 1/2 miles outside Craig, Colorado and parallels our 18-hole golf course.

Existing aeronautical facilities at the Airport includes one primary runway oriented 7/25 (northeast/sounthwest).

Runway 7/25 is paved with asphalt and is rated at 35,000 pounds for aircraft with single wheel gear and 40,000 pounds with aircraft with dual wheel gear.

Two access taxiways connect runway 7/25 to the aircraft-parking apron and building area. There are two turnaround taxiways on the runway.

The aircraft-parking apron consists of about 19,000 square yards of asphalt, with 60 tie down anchors installed in the tarmac.

The Craig-Moffat County Airport is Class G airspace and is a great place for touch and goes and practice without a lot of air traffic.

The airport offers full refueling services, short-term hanger space and reasonable tie-down fees. The first 15 days are free.

Our local airport supports Flight for Life™ transports to metropolitan hospitals and also supports the Bureau of Land Management for monitoring wildfires each summer.
