Call to Order – 10:30 am

Commissioner Broom called the meeting to order.

Broom made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Bohrer seconded the motion. Motion carried 2-0.

Agenda Items – Topic:

- 1) Moffat County School District Discussion- Scott Pankow, Board of Health

Pankow spoke about current COVID/School District strategies to return to pre-pandemic school function.

- 2) Moffat County School District/MCPH Lead Program Update- Scott Pankow and MCPH

Ladrow updated the Board about the Moffat County School District/MCPH Lead Program. She met with Jerod Ogden, Maintenance Director for the school district and they are completing Phase 1 of the project which includes identifying schools interested in participating in the program as well as MCPH providing community outreach and education. Phase 2 of the grant (if MCPH were to be awarded the grant) would include sampling of the schools and any day cares interested in participating in the voluntary program. The school district and MCPH will continue to work together on this project.

- 3) Diaper Program Update- MCPH

The Diaper Program is going well. 14,000 diapers have been given thus far to families in need of diapers. This program is funded through CDHS and Moffat County Public Health is serving as the Diaper Distribution Center.

- 4) MPCH Outreach Update-MCPH is continuing to distribute free carbon monoxide detectors, medication safety boxes, first aid kits and school supplies to Moffat County residents. The program has been very successful. Appointments can be made for these free supplies by contacting the Moffat County Public Health Department office.
