**Call to Order
Special County Board of Public Health Meeting**

Beck called the special Board of Public Health meeting to order.

- Suppression Plan:

Kari spoke about the new format (portal) that CDPHE is requiring for the submitted Suppression Plans. Even though the County had sent off their plan last week, we found out on Monday about this new format. Kari submitted that as soon as we were aware and has not heard anything back from the State yet.

- Scheduled Events Discussion:

All of the scheduled May events have been cancelled. For other, upcoming events, Kari advises the event planners to have their Mitigation Plans in place so they would be able to move forward accordingly, depending on what the State does.

Commissioner Cook asked about County Fair? Kari said she is not sure how that will happen. Dr. Harrington said he optimistic about the fair happening, it just might look a little bit different. Beck asked if it would be a good idea to start working on our Phase II variance request which would include events. Kari and Dr. Harrington advised that it might not be a bad idea to wait for our Phase I to be approved, just so we could see what we did right/wrong. But, it still won't hurt to have a draft plan in place at the ready.

Melody Villard (Grand Old West Days) – Asked about guidance for the submittal of plans for the variance/mitigation process. The High School Rodeo finals have moved their dates from May 21-24 to June 11-14 in hopes that it's something they still will be able to go forward with. Kari spoke about the electronic "dropbox" for submission of plans.

David Pressgrove (Bear River Young Life) – Will use this process to submit plans for their Father's Day weekend car show.

Cook asked about rental of the Pavilion; would it be up to the County to have a Mitigation Plan in place for that or just not rent it at all. Kari responded that if the renter understood that at this point, they could only have 10 participants. The general consensus is that it would be very difficult to monitor that and we probably would not do rentals at this point in time.

- Vulnerable Populations:

Seniors – Kari has been working with Housing Authority Director, Suzanne Hope, on keeping the seniors that live in Sunset Meadows I & II safe and healthy during this time.

- Business Support (5 Commitments of Containment – Your Personal Responsibility):

- 1) 6ft of Social Distance
- 2) Wash your hands
- 3) Cover your face in public
- 4) Stay home if you're sick

- 5) Seek testing immediately if you have symptoms
- CARES Act monies for signs/posters for community/business distribution
