# CLEAN-UP RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ALL OUTSIDE OPEN AREAS & PARKING LOTS

## > CLEAN-UP:

- Clean-up must be started no later than the Monday after the event
- All equipment must be removed within 24 hours after the end of your event
- All dirt/snow needs to be removed from track and arena
- All trash and broken glass <u>must</u> be picked up from parking areas, arenas, behind the bucking chutes/holding pen areas.
- Grandstand seating area and ground level area, including the front concrete area of the Grandstands.
- Put all trash into dumpsters or trash barrels.
- If any inside buildings are used, see clean-up regulations for that building.
- Includes any restrooms used

#### > HORSE STALLS:

- All stalls must be cleaned and raked to the dirt, using a spring (leaf) rake to finish stall clean-out. Remove <u>everything</u> to the dirt; fill in holes dug by pawing horses.
- Any additional clean-up work done by Moffat County staff will be deducted from deposit.
- Manure, hay, straw or other bedding must be piled in front of the stall in such a manner that the doors can be shut.
- Do not pile manure against the building

## **DEPOSITS:**

Only after deposits have been paid and required proof of insurance is turned in, will keys to stalls and buildings be given out. All management of stalls, concessions, etc. will be the renter's responsibility. Deposits will be refunded when all keys are turned in and clean-up has been completed to the approval of Fairgrounds management/staff.
